ADVANCING A LEGACY A Movement Going Forward

The initiative that saw Mission Ministries Philippines come into existence was started prior to 1984 by 2 retired Army Chaplains from the USA - John Lindvall and Stewart De Boer (both who have gone home to be with the Lord). After spending some time in Manila amid the extreme conditions of poverty that afflicted a majority of the population, especially children, John and Stewart collaborated with their church in California. John Lindvall was the Pastor. Along with some other friends from Asian Theological Seminary in Manila, where Stewart was President at the time, they prayed, sought God, and discussed starting a ministry in the Philippines. In 1984 Mission Ministries Philippines was born.

As educators themselves, John and Stewart knew that education was the key to creating better opportunities in life. With poverty rooted generationally, it was young children they wanted to reach out to, with a vision to end the cycle of poverty as a vounger generation grew. An Early Childhood Education initiative was started as the first school opened in 1984.

In a span of just a few years a holistic Gospel grassroots movement had begun through the efforts of Mission Ministries Philippines, using strategies developed through emergency relief, community and sustainable development, and social movement efforts.

"And that is what we did from the start. "We used the Early Childhood Education as a movement, a change catalyst. When we started there were 11 million preschool age kids in the Philippines but only 3 million had access to early childhood education. So essentially, and mainly because of poverty, we had about 8 million young children with no opportunity for education. We started our first school in the slums, and we have been moving forward ever since", Dr. Corrie De Boer (Co-Founder). Now over 30 years later, Mission Ministries Philippines has initiated over 1200 early childhood education programs, through the local church, in communities across the Philippines.

The movement continues forward...





